

Arts in Education Council of BC Fund GRANT GUIDELINES

About the Fund

The Arts in Education Council of BC Fund offers small grants of up to \$500 for educators or schools to support professional development for K-12 educators in British Columbia. These grants can be used to assist in the presentation or attendance of professional development workshops, clinics or seminars designed to increase the appreciation of the arts for teachers in BC schools.

This fund is a legacy of the Arts in Education Council of BC (AIECBC). ArtStarts hopes to honour the work of the AIECBC through the life of this fund.

Application process

- There are two application intakes per year: April and October. Upcoming deadlines are listed online at artstarts.com/aiecbc.
- Applications must be submitted before the deadline using the online form provided.
- Grants are distributed by lottery.
- A maximum of one application per organization per intake can be submitted.
- A maximum of one successful application per year per organization will be granted.
- Eligible expenses include: materials, supplies, professional fees, transportation costs for presenters/clinicians and professional development workshops.

Who can apply?

• K-12 educators and school administrators in British Columbia are eligible to apply for this grant.

Eligible projects must be:

• catered to the professional development of K-12 teachers in BC schools;

Vancouver, BC V6B 3A7

- designed to increase the appreciation of the arts;
- planned for the future (i.e. not already started or completed).

NOTE: As this is a professional development grant for teachers, proposals for projects designed for young people are not eligible.
