Family Volunteering is a great way for your family to spend quality time together while also giving back to the community. We understand that many families want the opportunity to spend meaningful time together, but there are fewer and fewer chances to do so with a busy schedule. By volunteering as a family at our gallery, you and your family will provide exhibition tours to the public, assist with special events, lead gallery activities and help out with light administrative duties. Volunteering together is a great way to spend quality time together on weekends while also providing kids with useful skills and experience. Family Volunteering is open to parents, guardians, brother, sisters, extended family members and even mentors. We just require an adult 19 or over and a maximum of 2 kids over the age of 8. The shifts are one 3 hour Saturday shifts per month.

As this is a volunteer unpaid position, no monetary compensation will be awarded.

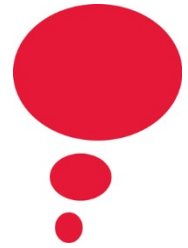
