

Dear Educator, The following is an example of a full day schedule for Milton Randall's school drumming workshop. Please adjust the times and grade levels accordingly to fit your needs. The oldest students are usually the target group and get quite a bit of the time so that they can perform an audience participation assembly at the end of the day. Younger students tend to tire sooner so they have less time and without the amount of time allotted to the target group, it would be difficult to have the day finale.

Recommended schedule:

9:00-10:20---target group grades 6,7, or two oldest grades

10:20-10:40----recess

10:40-11:15—k, 1,2,

11:15-12:00--- 3,4,5,

Lunch

1:00---1:30 pm. K's if no p.m. k's grade 6,7, come early

1:30-2:00—grade 6,7,

2:00-target group performs for school assembly, parents welcome.

2:30—dismiss from Gym---pack up

Questions:

How many students in the largest group ex ... how many 3,4,5, etc...

Chairs and benches available?

Are students available for set up 45 minutes before school starts? Generally around 10 – 15 is a good number depending on school size.

Special considerations? Ie split classes, other activity conflicts to work a round (example a field trip for grade 6's) etc...
