

Start by writing a sentence. Not sure how to start? How about: Once Upon a Time...

Now pass the piece of paper to your friend or classmate. Tell them to write a sentence (but don't tell them what to write about). When they are done, take the paper back and write another sentence yourself. Go back and forth and back and forth! What happens?



If you have a pen pal (someone you write letters or emails to), you could play this activity with them! If you have permission from an adult, you could also play this activity with a grandparent or family member on a text message.
