

ArtStarts' Guidelines for Third Party Events

- All third party fundraising events must be approved by ArtStarts before promoting or holding the event.
- ArtStarts will not assume financial, legal or managerial responsibility of a third party fundraising event.
- Event organizers are responsible for securing and paying for all necessary licenses, and must abide by all municipal, provincial and federal regulations.
- Event organizers must not state or imply that they represent ArtStarts. Event organizers must ensure that it is clear that they are an outside group that is raising funds in support of ArtStarts.
- Fundraising cannot be done by canvassing door-to-door.
- ArtStarts must approve the use of its name and/or logo, and have approval of use prior to publishing promotional materials.
- ArtStarts reserves the right to withdraw the use of its name and logo at any time if such use could damage its reputation.
- ArtStarts reserves the right to refuse support of third party fundraising events if the event/organizer is in contradiction of ArtStarts' mission or vision; is offensive, hateful, defamatory, or discriminatory; is inappropriate for children (e.g. tobacco, sexual, violent). The event can be directed at adults only, but should not be at odds with the fact that ArtStarts is an organization focused on young people.
- ArtStarts reserves the right to refuse support of third party fundraising event with political involvement.
- ArtStarts reserves the right to refuse support of third party fundraising events if there is not sufficient time to organize, plan or promote the event, or if ArtStarts does not have the capacity to support and event during a particular period of time.
- Funds should be submitted to ArtStarts within 30 days after the conclusion of the fundraising event
- Fundraising events that employ wording such as "Proceeds from this event will support ArtStarts in Schools" agree to donate 100% of proceeds to ArtStarts. Fundraising events that employ wording such as "Partial proceeds from this event will support ArtStarts in Schools" agree to donate a percentage of proceeds to ArtStarts. ArtStarts reserves the right to refuse support of third party fundraising events if they plan to donate less than 25% of proceeds.
