Artists, teachers, principals and PAC representatives in the First Nations Schools Association (FNSA) are highly encouraged to apply as AIC can fund up to 100% of all their project costs.

This grant is designed for you if you:

- are an educator looking to increase arts experiences for young people
- are interested in expanding opportunities for artists and develop their artistic excellence
- have a project idea but don't have the funds to cover the required material or artist fees

AIC is an opportunity for you to fund projects that help you deepen your curriculum, connect with your local community, and support the amazing work you are already doing to educate and engage with young people.
